

BASIC CARBON TERMS YOU NEED TO KNOW



CARBON CREDITS ARE TRADABLE CERTIFICATES THAT CONSTITUTE AN OFFSET OF 1 TON OF CO2 OR CO2e FROM THE ATMOSPHERE.



THE RELEASE OF CO2 INTO THE ATMOSPHERE. IT CAN ALSO BE A CATCHALL TERM RELATED TO OTHER GHG EMISSIONS WHEN QUANTIFIED AND CONVERTED TO CO2e.



A PROJECT THAT REDUCES OR REMOVES CARBON EMISSIONS FROM THE ATMOSPHERE TO COMPENSATE FOR UNAVOIDABLE EMISSIONS PRODUCED BY OTHERS.



CARBON TAX

A GOVERNMENT-REGULATED ENVIRONMENTAL TAX OR PENALTY THAT ORGANIZATIONS MUST PAY FOR THEIR EXCESSIVE PRODUCTION OF CO₂ AND OTHER GHG.



A NATURAL OR ENGINEERED RESOURCE THAT HAS THE ABILITY TO STORE AND REMOVE CARBON DIOXIDE FROM THE ATMOSPHERE.



CARBON NEUTRAL

ANTHROPOGENIC CO₂
EMISSIONS EMITTED INTO
THE ATMOSPHERE ARE
BALANCED WITH CARBON
DIOXIDE OFFSETS FROM
REDUCTION AND REMOVAL
PROJECTS.



A METRIC USED TO CALCULATE GHG EMISSIONS. IT COMBINES ALL GHGS INTO ONE BY COMPARING GLOBAL WARMING POTENTIAL AGAINST CO₂.



THERE ARE TWO TYPES: COMPLIANCE MARKET AND VOLUNTARY MARKET. BOTH MARKETS CONDUCT THE TRADE OF CARBON CREDITS.



CARBON REGISTRY

AN ORGANIZATION THAT VERIFIES AND VALIDATES THE REDUCTION AND REMOVAL OF CARBON EMISSIONS AND ISSUES CARBON CREDITS CERTIFICATES.



THE QUANTIFICATION OF CARBON EMISSIONS AND REDUCTIONS WHICH COMPLEMENTS GHG ACCOUNTING PROCESSES.
